On March 7, 1944, Fourth Protestant Reformed Church was organized, with thirty-three families and three individuals coming from First, and Roosevelt Park (called Second PRC, now Southwest). Rev. Hoeksema led the service, preaching from Ephesians 6:14. The first officebearers, chosen at

this meeting, were H. Meulenberg, C. DeJong, and P. Zuidema as elders, and J. Hager and A. Haan as deacons." After the morning service, this book will be distributed (no-charge) to confessing members of SE. The council's intent is that every household has a copy as well as each confessing member who realizes the importance of the book and desires their own copy. We thank our heavenly father for his faithfulness in preserving our existence for 75 years.
